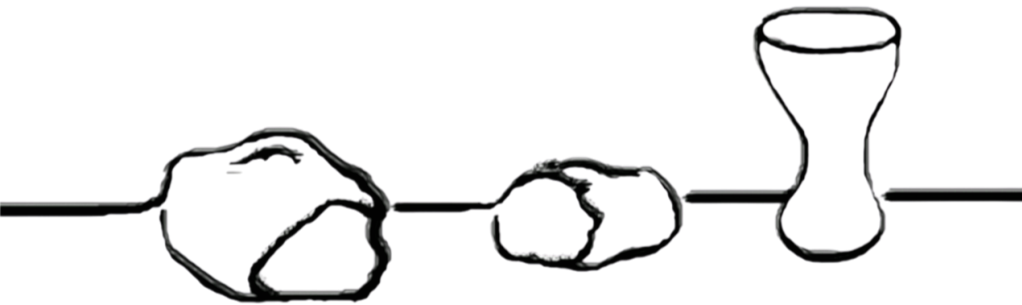

MAUNDY THURSDAY

Maundy Thursday is the holy day falling on the Thursday before Easter that commemorates the Last Supper of Jesus Christ with the Apostles.

On this day five events are remembered: the washing of the disciples' feet by Jesus Christ, the institution of the celebration of Communion at the Last Supper, the agony of Christ in the Garden of Gethsemane, the betrayal of Christ by Judas Iscariot, and Peter's denial of Christ in the courtyard. This year, we will also remember Jesus' trial before religious authorities and Pilate.



The word *Maundy* is derived from the Latin "mandatum," the first word of the phrase Jesus says at the Last Supper: "A new commandment I give unto you - that you love one another as I have loved you."
